

Including the Henri Nouwen Society in your will Sample Bequest Language for residents of Canada

<i>Specific Bequest (Unrestricted):</i> A gift of a specific dollar amount or property by a resident of Canada to the Henri Nouwen Society.
"I give, devise, and bequeath to the Henri Nouwen Society, (Canadian Charitable Registration Number 858978281 RR 0001), [Insert specific dollar amount or description of property] to be used to fulfill the mission and purpose of the Henri Nouwen Society as determined by the Henri Nouwen Society administration and governing board. Percentage Bequest (Unrestricted): A gift by a resident of Canada of a percent of his or her estate to the Henri Nouwen Society.
"I give, devise, and bequeath to the Henri Nouwen Society, (Canadian Charitable Registration Number 858978281 RR 0001) [Insert the word "ALL" or state the fraction or percentage] of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate to be used to fulfill the mission and purpos of the Henri Nouwen Society as determined by the Henri Nouwen Society administration and governing board. Residual Bequest: A gift by a resident of Canada to the Henri Nouwen Society of whatever is left of an estate after other distributions.
"I give, devise, and bequeath to the Henri Nouwen Society (Canadian Charitable Registration Number 858978281 RR 0001) [Insert the word "ALL" or a percentage] of the rest of my estate, of whatever kind and wherever situated to be used to fulfill the mission and purpose of the Henri Nouwen Society as determined by the Henri Nouwen Society administration and governing board. Language for a restricted bequest:

Some people may want to establish a named endowment or designate their bequest for a specific (restricted) purpose. Given that the gift is actually received after the death of the donor, it is important that the wording for a specific (restricted) bequest be prepared in a way that both honours the donor's intentions and meets the needs of the Henri Nouwen Society well into the future.
