


A Christmas Gift Alternative


Most Nouwen books can be easily ordered online. Many are available at your local bookstore.



A Father to the Fatherless

The Henri Nouwen Society is collaborating with Prison Fellowship Canada to address the issue of fatherlessness in Canada. The two organizations will introduce a new study of Henri Nouwen's *The Return of the Prodigal Son* to inmates in a number of prisons throughout the country, teaching and inspiring participants to discover the love of the Father.

Based on a program that was successfully implemented in South Africa, the study will help inmates learn to recognize and stand firm in their calling as fathers and husbands, with the goal of ending the generational cycle of hurt and pain.

Prison Fellowship operates in 118 countries around the world. If the initiative goes well in Canada, it may be extended to prisons in other countries. Please keep this outreach in your prayers. It's a unique opportunity to touch the lives of prisoners and their families with God's unconditional love.
