THE NEW READING ROOM

On September 21, the anniversary of Nouwen's death, we dedicated the Henri Nouwen Reading room at Light on the Hill (St. John's Anglican Church, north of Toronto). We had a wonderful gathering with the Spirit Movers, L'Arche's dance group, guest speaker Rev. Daniel Cho, and Rev. Arthur Boers serving the Eucharist at the graveside. Visitors can now explore the Reading Room with Nouwen's furniture, artifacts and a library packed with foreign translations of Henri's books. We hope you will stop by and visit.



RETURNING HOME: Capacity Building Campaign

In anticipation of the 30th anniversary of Henri Nouwen's death in 2026, we have launched a three year campaign to equip us for the next season of ministry and partnership. Our goals include:

- 1. Launch a new Nouwen Meditation App to make Henri accessible to thousands on their mobile devices. **2026 Goal: 50,000 subscribers**
- Revitalize churches with the Returning Home series calling congregations to contemplation, community, and care in action.
 2026 Goal: Engaging 250 Congregations
- Share God's love with prisoners through the Father to the Fatherless project using Henri's book The Return of the Prodigal Son.
 2026 Goal: Program reaching into 150 prisons world-wide
- Expand the Spanish Ministry with audio Daily Meditations.
 2026 Goal: 30,000 Spanish followers
- Resource and build the Nouwen Community through social media, podcasts, and webinars. 2026 Goal: One million podcast listens

It is this knowledge that informs her ready smile and frequent laughter. Tammy feels blessed that this role gives her the opportunity to introduce others to Henri's writing so that they too can choose joy!
