The **Henri Nouwen Society** is sustained by the financial gifts of people who experience a deep connection to Nouwen and his writing. A living legacy, the work of Henri Nouwen continues to nurture spiritual transformation through **publications, programs, and partnerships**. Here are some highlights from 2023:

A Spirituality of Fundraising

A paradigm-shifting talk given by Henri Nouwen has become one of his best known works among ministry leaders. A Spirituality of Fundraising recognizes the ministry and spiritual transformation that is possible through raising the resources needed to advance mission and ministry. In 2023, the Henri Nouwen Society partnered with World Vision to produce a five-part webinar series based on this work. Featuring both fundraisers and philanthropists, the series is an enriching and encouraging invitation to see God work through the ministry of fundraising. Plans are well underway for a whole new set of speakers for 2025.

A Father to the Fatherless

In 2023, a nine-part video project was developed in partnership with Prison Fellowship Canada. Based on Nouwen's *The Return of the Prodigal Son*, this project will see prisoners in 50 Canadian prisons receive a copy of the book and the opportunity to engage with the videos and workbook. Addressing the pain and fragmentation caused by fatherlessness, this program will bring hope and healing through relationship with the unconditional love of the Father. We are so grateful for the support of the Bridgeway Foundation and Carrick a Rede Foundation for this project. In 2024, we will prepare to expand the program internationally.

Spanish Ministry

Daily meditations en espanol were launched in January and we are now completing a full set of audio recordings of the meditations to play on Hispanic media.

Summer Meditation Series

We are so grateful to Robert Ellsberg for his presentation of our 2023 Summer Meditation Series based on his book, *A Living Gospel*. Featuring sessions on the lives of Dorothy Day, Thomas Merton, and Henri Nouwen, the series invited participants to see God’s story revealed through their own life journeys. Participants from all over the world registered and to-date the videos have been viewed more than 12k times. It is available on the Henri Nouwen YouTube channel.

Henri Nouwen Society Podcast

Hosted by Karen Pascal, fifteen brand new episodes of the Henri Nouwen, *Now & Then Podcast* were released in 2023 with a diverse and inspiring group of guests. In 2024, we will be releasing a new podcast series, *Love, Henri*, with new guests discussing letters written by Henri Nouwen.

Called to be Fruitful

In November, the Henri Nouwen Society held its first in-person event since the pandemic. Held in the beautiful chapel on the campus of Tyndale University, new home to our offices, this was an evening to celebrate the fruitfulness of the Henri Nouwen Society under the leadership of, now-retired Executive Director, Karen Pascal.

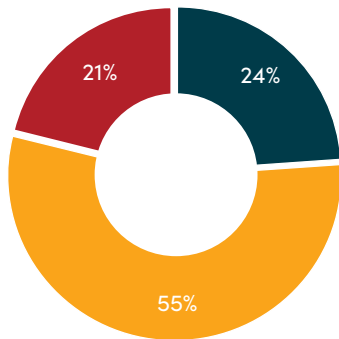
2023 Financial Report

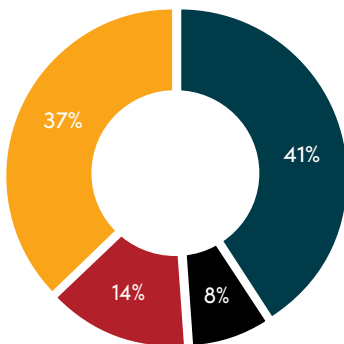
(Year ended December 31, 2023
