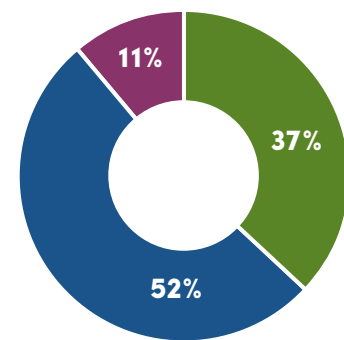
From Fear to Love

CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL SUMMARY

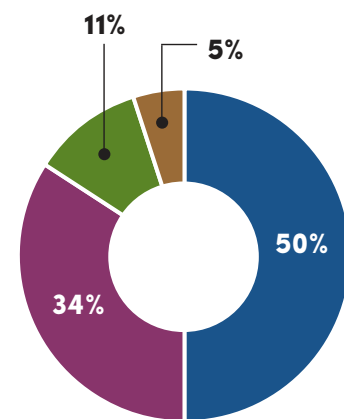
(YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2022

A Father to the Fatherless

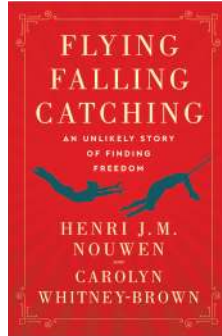
The Henri Nouwen Society is collaborating with Prison Fellowship Canada to address the crisis of fatherlessness. This partnership will offer a study of Nouwen's *The Return of the Prodigal Son* to inmates in prisons across Canada, inviting participants to be transformed by the love of the Father. Flying, Falling, Catching – Hits the Stores!

Henri's passion for the flying trapeze and belief that it offered a powerful analogy to living a spiritual life finally made its way into a book – *Flying, Falling, Catching*. Twenty-six years after his death, his friend and colleague Carolyn Whitney-Brown frames Henri's unpublished trapeze writings with the true story of his rescue by paramedics through a hotel window following his first heart attack. Published by HarperCollins.

In 2022, we acquired the rights to the Spanish translation of *You Are the Beloved* and laid the groundwork to launch Henri's popular Daily Meditations in Spanish for 2023. To oversee the translation, we hired *Coordinador para América Latina* – Dr. Hugo Herfst, who has been an amazing addition to our small team.

Expanding Henri's Legacy Through Webinars on YouTube

In July, we presented the 5-part webinar series called “From Fear to Love: Spiritual Grounding in Anxious Times” with Rev. Marjorie J. Thompson, thanks to the generous support of the Ross Mitchell Family Foundation. Almost 7,000 participated from all around the world! Another webinar, that played a significant part in growing our YouTube channel in 2022, was “Peacework,” featuring long-time activists Martin Sheen and Fr. John Dear.
